



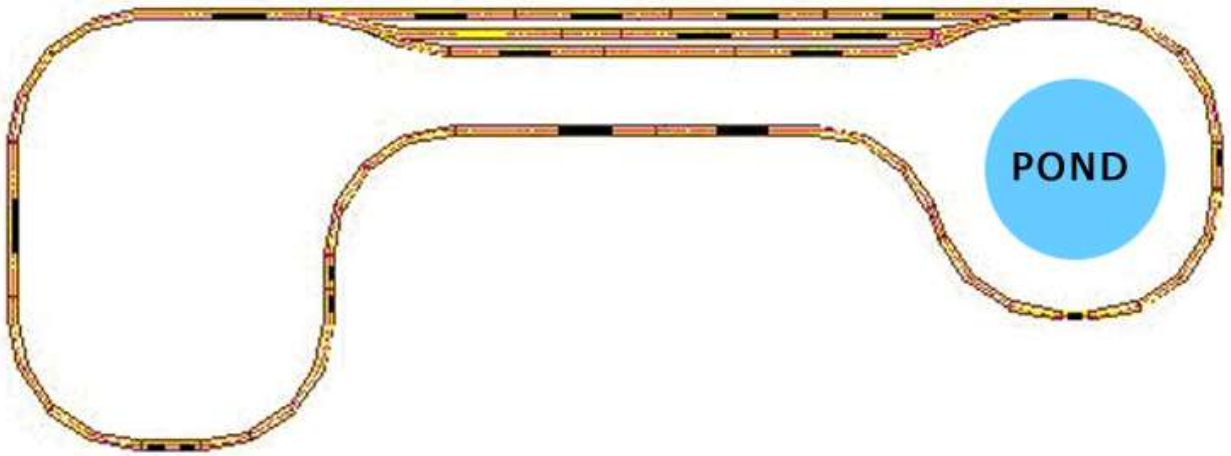
## Trackplan

Construction began on the club's layout in April, 2003. The following information came from documentation of the planning, construction, and future expansion plans for the railroad.

### Phase 1 (Current Status)

The first phase is a simple bent dog bone loop with two storage tracks. It measures 15'-7" x 40'-0". The yard allows for two or more trains to be available to run. The four switches would be manually operated at this time with remote action added at a later time. (2008 Note: The switches are now remote controlled.) Opposite the yard would be the location of the fixed control panel. This would house the power supplies and power routing switches for the various blocks on this first segment.

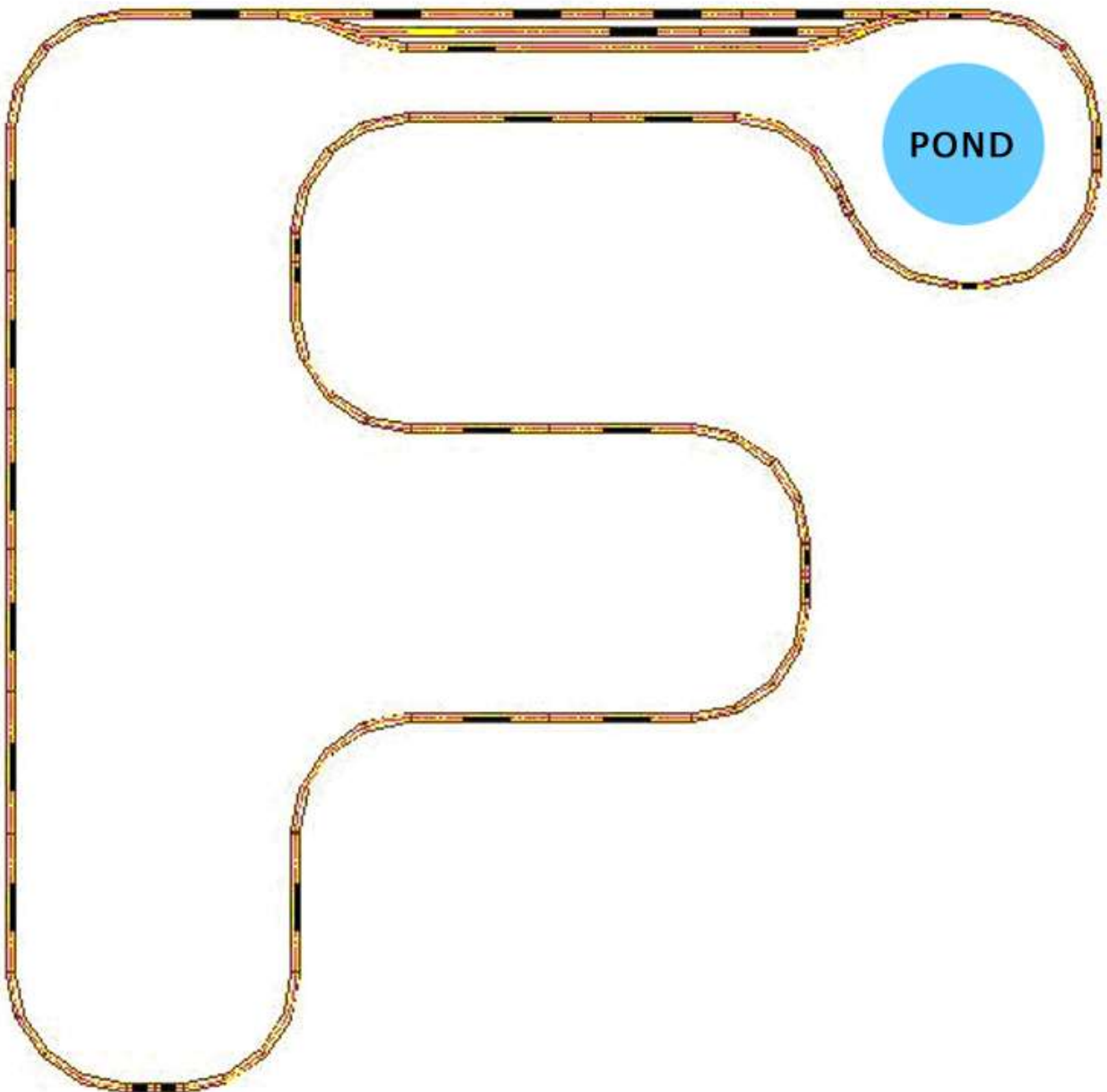
### HOTGG Club Layout Trackplan



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### Future Expansion (Phase 2)

The Second Phase is an extension of the first stage in area and track. This would expand the layout to 40'-0" x 40'-0". This area would allow temporary yards, townships, and/or details areas that can be later moved to the final segment. This detailing has been left off to allow you to add your ideas for growth in this area. Control of this area would still be maintained at the original control panel.



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### Future Expansion (Phase 3)

The Final phase would add a twice-folded loop of track to the center portion of the second phase. Sufficient room should be available to bring existing or new scenes into this area. A new control panel located in the large open area near the three level tracks section would control this segment. Or these control panels could be designed into one complete unit located to the outside of the peninsula.
